## COVID-19 LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Do not bring your child to lessons if they have a fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, muscle aches, headache or loss of smell or taste.
- Maximum one chaperone per skater. This includes siblings unless the sibling(s) are also enrolled in the current ACC Learn to Skate Program.
- Enter facility through West facility entrance doors (parking lot closest to water tower), check-in table will be located in main hallway, just outside the Sports Complex entrance
- Masks are REQUIRED to enter the facility- children 6 years of age and older are REQUIRED to wear a face mask inside the facility per Executive Order 20-81. Skaters are NOT required to wear a mask while skating on the ice
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to lesson time and come prepared and dressed to enter ice upon arrival to facility
- Class sizes have been modified to a maximum of 10 participants and 2 instructors per class/pod
- Students will remain in their class/pod the entire time they are on ice
- Instructors have adjusted lesson plans to ensure safe social distancing while out on ice
- Any items/toys/props used by students during lessons will be collected by instructors for proper sanitation
- Staff and Instructors will be required to wear masks in common areas where social distancing may not be possible
- Bring a filled water bottle to avoid use of water fountains
- Students must always have gloves and helmets on while out on ice (Basic 2 students helmets optional)
- Exit the facility immediately following lessons
- Vending machines and Subway concessions available for take-out only. No food consumption in facility.

**Groups not following arena, CDC, MDH and other guidelines or directions given by staff/instructors will be asked to leave facility.
